## 2009 Fall Crop Update

Small grain harvest is about 99% complete and we are now starting to harvest corn, sunflowers, and soybeans. As we continue to finish our fall's work, it is still important that we keep track of truckload records when filling our bins and quonsets or piling your crop on the ground. These records are very important when we do your 2009 production reports or in an audit situation.

Although this year's crop produced above average yields, there were some areas where hail or weather conditions created a claim situation. If you were caught in one of these areas please note the dates at the bottom of the page as to the last day to file a crop claim. As always, if you even think you have a claim, call us to get one filed and we will get an adjuster out to you right away.

We still have a few farmers that we haven't received maps or 578's from. We will be more than happy to stop out to your farm and pick them up, or if you are in town stop by and we will photo copy them for our files. For the past couple years we have been scanning your maps and 578's into our system. We are then able to print them off when needed, so your claims can be processed faster.
